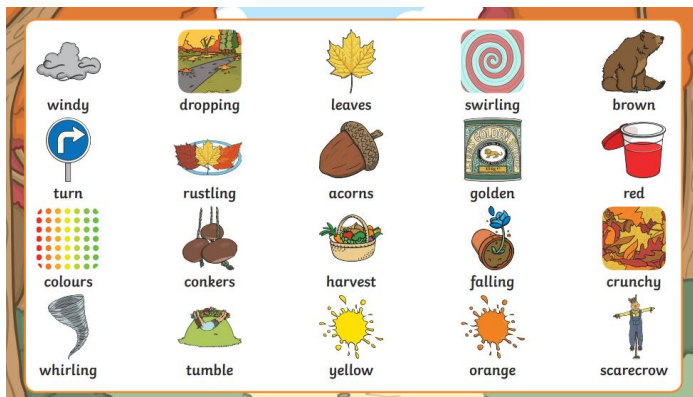
Traditional Tales
