What? (Key Knowledge)	
Year One Key Question: What do people say about God? Topic Question: Why do Christians say that God is a 'Father'?	
Christians refer to God as 'Father'.	
Christians compare God to a loving parent.	
They believe God is loving and forgiving and that this is shown in the parable and in Jesus' life on Earth.	
Christians talk to God to; ask for things, be thankful for things or to ask for help.	
Christians use images to focus on and rosary beads to help count prayers.	
The parable of The Lost Son (sometimes called 'The Prodigal Son') is used to express the 'Father-heart' that Christians believe God has for humans.

Spelling	Definition/ Sentence
prayer	A way of talking to God.
Father	A parent. Someone who has children. Sometimes called a Dad or Daddy.
Bible	The Christian holy book.
forgiveness	Understanding when someone has upset or hurt you.

church	A Christian place of worship.
Lord's Prayer	A prayer used by Christians.
Love	A feeling of total joy and connection with another person or thing. A safe feeling.
Christians	People who believe that Jesus Christ was the Son of God. They practice Christianity.
God (In Christianity)	The one who created and rules over all the world.
