
# <u>Year Two Newsletter</u>

### Classes 2L and 2H



This term the children will be exploring the following topics:

#### **Science** - Animals including Humans Pupils will be taught to:

- Identify that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

<u>How can parents help?</u> You could discuss the different foods you eat at home from the food groups and whether they should eat them a lot or a little.

In **Maths**, we will be learning about division and multiplication and written methods of addition and subtraction crossing ones. We will be also looking at length in metres and centimetres.

## To help parents could:

- Ensure children understand the place value of two-digit numbers.
- Practice counting in 2s, 5s, 10s on and back and begin to learn associated multiplication and division facts.
- Use written methods such as column for addition and subtraction
- Try measuring different objects at home in cm with rulers and tape measures.

In **PE** our units this half term are Yoga learning about body control and Fundamental Movement Skills focussing on movement, defending and passing.

Our PE days this term are:

- Outdoor PE: Friday
- Indoor PE: Wednesdav

## Messages and reminders

- This half term we will be taking the children on a walk around our local area.
- Homework is given out on a Tuesday and due on the following Monday.
- Spelling tests are on a Monday.
- Reading books should be read at home regularly and sent into school every day so children can read with an adult in school. Please write a comment in their diary every time you read with your child.
- Children will also bring home a school library book which is to encourage reading for pleasure. It is not the expectation that they should be able to read this book themselves, but they may wish to.

In **Literacy** we will be reading and writing stories with a theme. Our focus text will be The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch linked to our Science Healthy living. We will be writing a narrative, writing instructions linked to our DT work making a healthy wrap and writing a poem linked to our firework poetry unit.

In **History**, we will be continuing to learn all about Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder plot and why we celebrate Bonfire Night.

In **Geography**, our unit is a local area study where we will be using maps to study the geographical features of Widnes.

In **DT**, we will be designing, making and evaluating a healthy snack and learning to use the bridge and claw grip when slicing food safely.

In **RE**, our unit is Christianity, Jesus: 'Why do Christians say that Jesus is the 'Light of the world'?'

In **Computing** we will be making games exploring algorithms and coding.
