**Yes, it's back! The Great Big Dance Off will be held on Wednesday 23rd April at the Parr Hall in Warrington.**

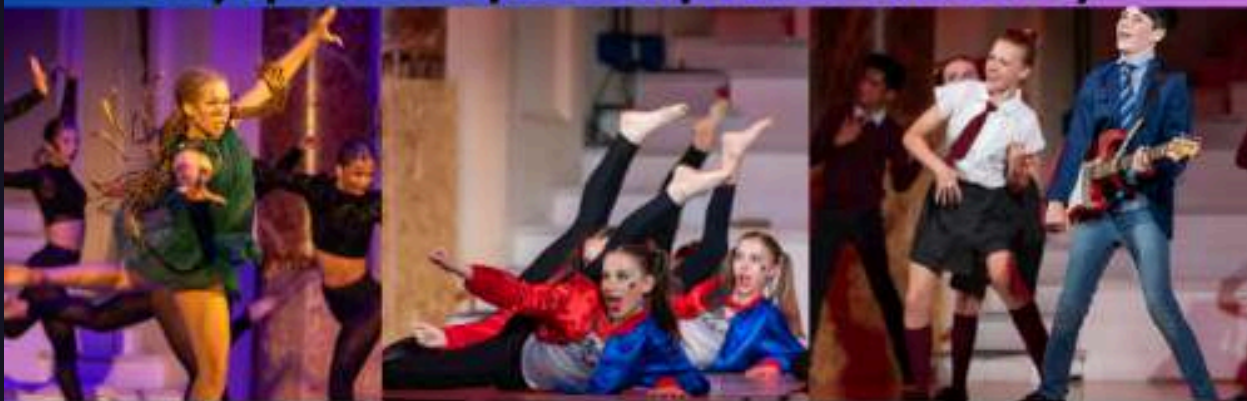
**Do you love to dance? Would you love to perform on a stage in front of a huge audience? If so, make sure you audition to be apart of the dance group!**

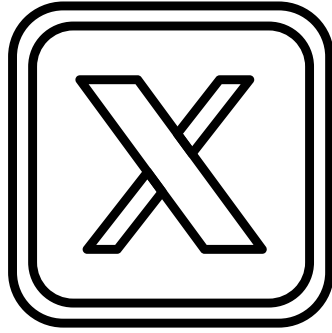
