

**What? (Key Knowledge)**

What do people say about God?

The focus is to encourage pupils to consider Allah's role in creating and sustaining the world, and humankind's response to Allah. Pupils should think about and reflect on their responsibility towards creation. They should begin to develop an understanding of how Muhammad (pbuh) is seen as a role model for Muslims and how the teachings of the Prophet might influence how and why a Muslim might care for the natural world. The experiences of the life of the prophet in this unit this should be explored through story.
