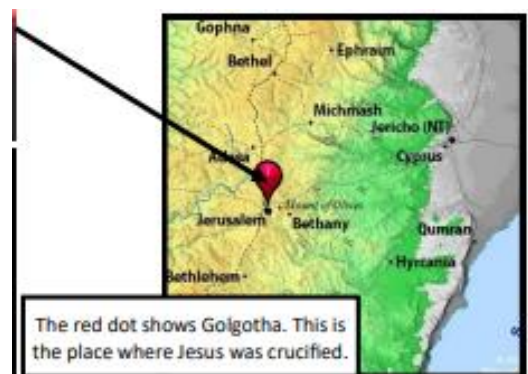

RE Focus	Christianity (Jesus)	Year 6	Term: Spring 2 nd Half Term

What? (Key Questions)
Is life like a journey? Why do Christians believe Good Friday is good?
What? (Key Knowledge)
Explore the events of Holy Week and Easter Sunday in the Christian religion. This builds on their prior knowledge of Lent, the Easter Story and the concept of Jesus' sacrifice. The children will focus on Christian beliefs about suffering and how these are responded to and commemorated through the events of Holy Week. Through study of Eucharist in different denominations, pupils will identify how Christians view the death and resurrection of Jesus as a source of guidance and comfort. The children will reflect on whether suffering can make a person stronger and who or what they can turn to when facing difficulties.
Key Knowledge
Know that Jesus was crucified on a cross at Golgotha.
Know that Good Friday is when Jesus was crucified.
Know that Easter Sunday is when Jesus rose from the dead.
Retell the events of Holy Week and know the order of these.
Understand that the Eucharist is part of a religious service where the Last Supper is remembered.
Know that the bread and the wine represent Jesus' body and blood as shared in the Last Supper.
