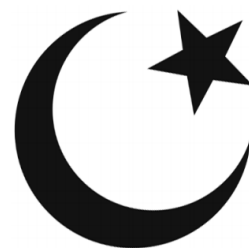

RE Focus	Islam	Year 6	Term: Spring 1 st Half Term

What? (Key Questions)
Is life like a journey? What is Hajj and why is it important to Muslims?
What? (Key Knowledge)
Explore the Five Pillars of Islam and how these beliefs and values impact on the life of a Muslim. Pupils will consider the pilgrimage to Mecca and completing Hajj. They will explore what it means to be a Hajji, reflecting on the personal journey a Muslim will make both physically and spiritually. The children will explain how a journey might change someone even after the journey itself is over. Pupils will also consider their own life experiences and suggest how their lives have changed. They will consider the challenges that people may face during the journey of life and the support that may be needed as they move through their own life journey.
Key Knowledge
The Five Pillars of Islam are Shahadah, Zakat, Salat, Sawm and Hajj.
The Ummah is the brotherhood of Islam. This is important as it makes a person feel part of the Muslim Community.
Hajj is a pillar of Islam which allows a person to perform the pilgrimage of a lifetime.
This is an important pillar as it makes Muslims feel closer to God and encourages them to be a better person and Muslim.
Muslims look towards the beliefs and values of Islam to guide a person through life.
Origins
Islam is the second largest religion in the world after Christianity. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approximately 1.8 billion Muslims worldwide. • Islam is the world's fastest growing religion. • The Qur'an is the major holy text of Islam. The Hadith is another important book. • Muslims follow the Islamic calendar, which is based on lunar events. • The Qur'an is considered the most important holy book among Muslims. • Muslims worship at a Mosque.
